

How to Fix Resident Evil 5 Re5dx9 Exe Error

Resident Evil 5 is a popular survival horror game that was released in 2009. However, some players have encountered an error message when trying to launch the game on their PC. The error message says: "RE5DX9.EXE - Fatal Application Exit (i) E_FAIL : XLiveInitialize (&xii)". This error means that the game cannot find the re5dx9.exe file or the xlive.dll file, which are essential for running the game. Cause 1: Antivirus Program
