

Best Buy Samsung S8 Repair [VERIFIED]



Rolling out starting this week for some models, 100 Best Buy stores in the United States will be equipped to offer repairs for Samsung Galaxy S and Galaxy Note series devices. Galaxy S8 through S21 and Note 8 through Note 20 devices will be available in this program. Samsung phone owners can receive same-day repairs on most Samsung phones at over 100 Best Buy locations nationwide. Repairs are completed by Samsung-certified Geek Squad agents equipped with knowledge of how to use Samsung genuine parts. Samsung wants to make it easier to get your broken Galaxy phone fixed. The electronics maker on Wednesday announced that it is partnering with uBreakiFix, an independent repair chain, to bring same-day, in-person repair service for more users of Galaxy handsets in the US.

Apple's tried-and-true tablet, the base model iPad, is arguably the best value out of Apple's tablet lineup, and experts agree. Avi Greengart, a consumer tech analyst at Techsponential, said the iPad is the most versatile tablet on the market today. The Fire HD 10 is affordable, faster than ever, and doubles as an Echo smart speaker, with Alexa awaiting your commands. ZDNET's Jason Cipriani tested this cheap tablet for a few weeks and was impressed with its versatility and performance, noting it can "work, in a pinch, if your main laptop or computer is being repaired, or you're looking to do light work while traveling." You can get it with 32GB or 64GB of storage, but don't fret if that's not enough. It has microSD card support for up to another 512GB of storage. If you're looking for an Android tablet, the Samsung Galaxy Tab s8 Ultra is one of the best Android tablets. The Tab S8 Ultra features a 14.6-inch Super AMOLED display, runs on the Android 12 operating system, and Samsung's S Pen stylus is included in the box. When ordering your Tab S8 Ultra, you can equip it with 512GB of storage and 16GB of memory for \$1,399, however, it's likely overkill. Dan Gookin, an author of technology books, said that Samsung's lineup of tablets is the best option for Android users who want good hardware in a tablet: "I believe Samsung is the only major player left for the Android tablet market, which makes them a good choice if you want to stay on Planet Android," he said. Apple's 2022 iPad Pro lineup is by far the most capable and impressive iPad lineup we've seen, making it our best overall pick as a laptop replacement. It's also the most expensive, by a long shot. The design hasn't changed all that much on the outside, but on the inside, you'll find Apple's M2 processor which consists of 20 billion transistors - 25% more than M1. It's the same exact processor that Apple is using in the new 13-inch MacBook Pro and MacBook Air. Where the iPad Pro is the model for those who want nothing but the best, the iPad Air is the model for those who want to use the tablet for work and play, without big sacrifices in performance or features. ZDNET's Jason Cipriani reviewed the iPad Air (2022) and said if you're in the market for an iPad (and the base model and iPad Mini isn't enough for you), then the iPad Air is "where your search should begin and, likely, end." The more Apple pays attention to the iPad Air, the less the 11-inch iPad Pro makes sense. Starting at \$599, the iPad Air comes with 64GB or \$749 for 256GB of storage. You can add cellular to it for an extra \$130. For (almost) everyone, this is the best iPad to get if you have the cash to spend but don't want to go all out. When it comes to drawing tablets, Wacom is one of the industry leaders. With virtually no lag and 8,192 levels of pressure sensitivity in the battery-free pen included, this no-screen tablet is the best one on the market for professional artists looking to create while providing a natural drawing experience. Anne Leavitt, a former teacher and founder and CEO of Homeschool Newbie, told ZDNET that the Fire HD 8 Kids Tablet is the best tablet for children on the market: "Parents will appreciate the complete parental control features that allow them to set up profiles and customize content for each child," she said. "Plus, Amazon FreeTime Unlimited comes included with the tablet for one year." The 10th-generation iPad is my pick for the best tablet. Experts like tech author Dan Gookin and analyst Avi Greengart and ZDNET's own June Wan also agree. They all named the iPad as their favorite tablet today. I considered my own experiences in using some of these tablets, as well as the reviews of other ZDNET writers. I also researched the top tablets from renowned brands and paid attention to the tablets' feature sets, price points, and integrations with other products. Finally, I reached out to experts in various fields who have used tablets for their takes on which tablets are best and what features are most important to them. The offer runs for two weeks, from June 13 through June 27. It will not apply to screen replacements through uBreakiFix, Best Buy, and Samsung repair vans. You

are also out of luck if you have an international model that was not officially sold in the US. Samsung charges upwards of \$200 to replace the cracked display on almost all its flagship Galaxy S and Note lineup of phones. The Galaxy S22 and S21 Ultra screen replacements typically cost a whopping \$289. For its mid-range A series, the pricing is mainly in the range of \$129 to \$159, while for budget phones, it starts from \$79. You can find the official display repair pricing for all Samsung devices on its support page. The best Samsung tablets are top-tier Android tablets that are well-designed, perform well, and last a long time on a single charge. They also tend to come with Samsung apps and technologies that improve on the stock Android tablet experience, which is a rarity in the world of Android devices. The Galaxy Tab S8 is good at a lot of things, but it's best at being a general-purpose Android tablet. You can use it to get work done in a pinch, but in my experience it's best enjoyed as a speedy all-purpose device for making work and play a bit more enjoyable. On the couch, it's great for gaming or reading comics, and at work it's nice to have as a note-keeping device or secondary display, especially if you go to the trouble of investing in the Galaxy ecosystem and making your workspace DeX-friendly. After spending a few weeks testing and using the A7 Lite I can confidently tell you it's far from the best Samsung tablet on the market. But it is quite a handy little device that's well worth your consideration if you need a capable Android tablet for not a lot of money. The best addition to the 2021 model is the 12-megapixel selfie camera with support for Center Stage. The camera will ensure you're always visible in the frame, handy if you're cooking and FaceTiming with mom. You also get Apple's class-leading ecosystem of tablet-optimized apps, which truly make this a slate capable of entertainment and work. The latter is especially true if you hook up Apple's Smart Keyboard (or a third-party alternative). It supports the first-gen Apple Pencil too, but this is the only iPad with a larger air gap between the glass and screen. There's a discernible space between your fingertip and the actual pixels, which makes using the iPad feel a little less natural than its siblings. If you need a slate for sketching, upgrade to another iPad. Unfortunately, the price has jumped up, which is why Apple continues to sell the 9th-gen model. There's also only first-gen Apple Pencil support, and the air gap between the screen and glass remains, so it's not the best iPad for sketching. It supports the Magic Keyboard Folio and the Smart Folio case, but we recommend you go with a third-party keyboard to save some cash. The price has dipped to \$400 often, so try to catch it on sale. If you want to do some work on your tablet, get Apple's iPad Air (8/10, WIRED Recommends). Thanks to the M1 processor, it's the most powerful tablet for the money. You can play demanding games, edit batches of RAW photos, render 3D designs, and so much more. Apple's recent strides in iPadOS make it easier to multitask than ever, too. This slate delivers slim bezels around the 10.9-inch screen and USB-C for charging, and it supports the second-generation Apple Pencil (Amazon), which magnetically attaches to the top and recharges wirelessly. That also makes this one of the best tablets for sketching, as the laminated display offers a more natural drawing experience. There's no Face ID, but Touch ID is integrated into the power button. I've been using Samsung's Galaxy Tab S8 for several months, and it's hard to find many faults with it. The 11-inch screen, while LCD, is sharp, colorful, bright, and a perfect size. The speakers sound great, performance is practically flawless, and it comes with a stylus that magnetically sticks to the back of the slate. Samsung's DeX mode lets you go into a desktop-like environment to crank out some light work as well, which is a nice perk. It's pricey though, so it's best if you can find it on sale.

Keychron K3 Pro Mechanical Bluetooth Keyboard for \$94: If you want to use a third-party Bluetooth keyboard with your tablet, a cheap one (like this Logitech) will do the job perfectly. But if you're a mechanical keyboard snob like me, this Keychron is an upgrade that's pretty easy to tote around. You can connect it to multiple devices and switch between them quickly; the keys light up in different, configurable colors; and best of all, it delivers the clickety-clackety experience you want with a mechanical keyboard. It needs to be recharged every three to four days, but you can also use it plugged in. You get three cameras: a 13-megapixel wide lens, a 6MP ultrawide lens, and a 12MP front camera for all the cool selfies you want to take ... although we're not sure if a tablet is the best device for photography. You can get far better photos and angles from a smartphone. However, the tablet's camera is great for video conferencing and scanning documents, in case you decide to take it

to work.
