# How to Download Jailer Songs

To prevent piracy and copyright infringement, this option isn't offered on the YouTube Music website or in the free version of the service.

However, there are also unofficial ways of downloading music from YouTube. By converting YouTube videos into MP3 format, you can download their audio tracks to listen to offline, without the accompanying visuals — and adverts. Be aware that there are specific rules around what you can download without violating YouTube's Terms of Service (we've covered this in a section below) and Google has been clamping down on so-called "stream rippers" that are designed to extract and save music from YouTube videos. Fortunately, there are a couple of workarounds for downloading music from YouTube, though we should stress that these shouldn't be used for making copies of copyrighted audio content (again, see section below).

Here are two options for downloading jailer songs legally:

### Option 1: Subscribe to YouTube Music or YouTube Premium

This is the official and legal way to download music from YouTube. By paying a monthly fee, you can access millions of songs and playlists on the YouTube Music app, and download them for offline playback. You can also enjoy other features such as background play, ad-free videos, and original content on YouTube Premium. Here's how to subscribe and download jailer songs using this method:

1. Download the YouTube Music app from the Google Play Store (Android) or the App Store (iOS).
2. Open the app and sign in with your Google account.
3. Tap on your profile picture at the top-right corner and select Settings.
4. Tap on Get Music Premium and follow the instructions to choose a plan and enter your payment details.

If you don't want to pay for a subscription, you can still download music from YouTube legally, as long as you respect the rights of the creators. Some music on YouTube is royalty-free, which means you can use it without paying any fees or royalties to the owner. Other music is licensed under Creative Commons, which means you can use it for free, as long as you follow the terms and conditions specified by the owner. For example, some Creative Commons licenses require you to give credit to the source, or only use the music for non-commercial purposes.

To find royalty-free or Creative Commons licensed music on YouTube, you can use the following methods:

- Go to YouTube's Audio Library, which offers thousands of free songs and sound effects that you can download and use for any project. You can browse by genre, mood, instrument, duration, or attribution. To download a song, click on the download icon next to it. You can also filter by license type to see which songs require attribution or not.
- Search for "jailer songs" on YouTube and look for videos that have a Creative Commons license. You can identify them by the CC logo at the bottom-right corner of the video thumbnail or under the video description.
